Why choose PATA as your place of study?

PATA (UK) is a charitable company supporting and developing high quality childcare, education, training and play for children from birth to 16 their families and childcare professionals.

Our courses are flexible and are offered on a part time basis with the expectation of 4-6 hours private study per week. The L2 and L3 courses are also offered as Apprenticeships for eligible students.

Who chooses to study with PATA?

We currently support students on both long and short study programmes from entry level (Introduction to Children's Play) through to national L2 Certificate, L3 Diploma and the L4 and L5 diplomas. These courses are run by qualified tutors and assessors who can offer support and guidance throughout your study programme. The courses are run from our training centre in Gloucester within easy access for most of the county. The course delivery includes:

- Taught workshops with knowledge input from the tutors
- Work based observation by qualified assessors
- Home tasks and a choice to complete graded assignments for some units
- Access to computers for word processing or internet research
- Selected texts are available for use on site or short term loan.
- On site computer/internet access available

Tutors are available for support and guidance through the taught sessions and remotely through email so you will always have access to help when you need it.

In addition PATA offers a series of personal development and community learning workshops for professionals, parents, carers and young adults living and working in Gloucestershire and its border counties. Further information can be accessed via the PATA Website.
