

# L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools (STL)



The L2 certificate is suitable for younger learners and those new to the role of classroom assistant. It provides an induction to schools as organisations, the policies and practice, and the opportunities to develop skills supporting classroom activities.

## Entry requirements

Ideally you will hold GCSE Mathematics, English Language and ICT (Grades D-G) or L1 equivalencies. Tutors will advise at interview the level and qualification that is most appropriate for each learner.

## Work based course

Employed/volunteering in school setting = minimum 2 sessions per week (equivalent to 6 hours must include at least 1 morning session) with at least one term's experience. Working under supervision.

## What is this course about?

Completing this course successfully will increase your understanding of how best to support children in their learning and class teachers / fellow teaching assistants / support workers in their teaching.

## What will I study?

To achieve this course you must complete a total of 30 credits made up in the following way: 24 credits from mandatory units including

- Child and young person development
- Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people
- Communication and professional relationships
- Equality, diversity and inclusion
- Help improve own and team practice in schools
- Maintain and support relationships
- Support children and young people's health and safety
- Support children and young people's positive behaviour
- Support learning activities

A minimum of 6 credits from a range of 15 optional units including: schools as organisations, contribute to supporting bilingual learners, invigilate tests and examinations, provide displays in schools, support assessment for learning, support children and young people with disabilities and special educational needs.

## How will I learn?

Completion of the qualification will consist of workshops, private study and coursework.

Assessment - by qualified and experienced assessor in the workplace to demonstrate your competence. This will include: planning activities for your assessor to observe you doing.

Progression onto level 3 Diploma. Supervised job roles in classroom support.
