

L5 Diploma in Leadership for the Children and Young People's Workforce – Advanced Practice



This qualification is one of only two approved as full and relevant by the National College for Teaching and Leadership and is equivalent to Foundation degree level. It provides the opportunity to develop and demonstrate leadership qualities according to the job role. It builds on knowledge and practice from L3 and provides a 'work based' route to degree study.

Entry requirements:

1 year course: Full and relevant L4 or full and relevant L3 with 3+ years post qualifying
2 year course: Full and relevant L3 plus 1 year post qualifying
GCSE Mathematics and English Language (Grades A* - C) or recognised equivalences

Work based course

Employed within a senior position such as room leader, SENCo, or a practitioner with at least three years' experience.

What is this course about?

This course is aimed at senior practitioners who wish to raise to national degree level their understanding of issues about children and their learning and development.

What will I study?

To achieve this course you must complete a total of **80** credits made up in the following way. **46** credits from mandatory units, including:

- Use and develop systems that promote communication
- Promote professional development
- Champion equality, diversity and inclusion
- Develop H&S & risk management policies and procedures
- Working in partnership
- Understand child and young persons development
- Lead practice that supports positive outcomes
- Safeguarding
- Lead practice in promoting well-being and resilience

28 credits from a range of **29, Group B and 4, Group C optional units**. Guidance will be given to support unit choices as a **maximum of 6** credits can come from **Group C**.

How will I learn?

This course is work based and therefore very practical. Course delivery will be through seminars, tutorials and a personalised learning programme to meet your individual practice and research needs. The course is on a part time study basis with home learning packs and seminars to consolidate knowledge and prepare for written accounts as well as direct observation of practice in the work setting. Those taking this course must choose optional units that relate to their current job role.

Career prospects

These courses are suitable for those interested in working with young children at an advanced level in a variety of settings. The course is Foundation Degree level and is accepted by several universities for progression onto degrees.
