



Artemis Children's Workforce Induction Programme Course information.

The e-learning programme reflects real life situations and has a range of activities to ensure that everyone's learning style is accommodated. It takes about 8 hours to complete, however it can be done in less and you do not have to complete it all in one go, you can do one module at a time and return to the programme at a later date to continue where you left off.

This course:

- Is for everyone working with, and supporting children, young people and their families.
- Is a major part of your induction to working with and supporting children, young people and their families.
- Does not replace an employer's induction programme but can work as part of it.
- Reflects the Artemis philosophy of multi-agency working providing a common language.
- Provides a solid base for multi-disciplinary working
- Will signpost you to further learning and development opportunities and information.
- Upon completion it will provide you with a certificate of achievement which is recognised across the Children's Workforce.

The 14 modules covered gives new entrants to the workforce a comprehensive understanding of the issues they might face in their day to day working, in addition they help to reinforce multi disciplinary working; giving a better understanding of roles and responsibilities closing the safe guarding net.
